

## SANTA ROSA JC HOLDS OFF CCSF FOR CCCAA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TITLE

VENTURA (March 13, 2011) – Guard Mia Greco had 16 points and four assists to lead Santa Rosa JC to a 52-45 victory over top seed City College of San Francisco for the California Community College Athletic Association women's basketball championship Sunday at the Ventura College Athletic Event Center.

It was the second title for Santa Rosa (28-6), which won previously in 1988. CCSF finished 27-6 and is still looking for its first state women's crown. It was the first appearance in the finals for San Francisco.

Santa Rosa grabbed the lead for good on a basket by all tourney Ashley Morgan a minute before halftime and made it 26-21 on a 3-pointer by tourney MVP Greco. It was 26-23 at the break.

Santa Rosa stretched the advantage to 37-29 with 12:55 left on a putback and free throw by 6-0 Marie Sweet.

The Bearcubs held CCSF season scoring leader Janis Peterson (21.9 average) scoreless until 7 minutes were left in the game and she finished with just three points.

Shawnte Taylor led CCSF with 15 points and eight rebounds

All-tournament Jan Tsurumoto added 12 points for Santa Rosa..

Coast North Conference champion CCSF and Big 8 champ Santa Rosa had split two tournament meetings in the fall.

--CCSF had been looking for the first official sweep of men's and women's titles after winning the men's championship earlier in the day.
