

**CCSF WINS NORTHERN CALIFORNIA FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION TITLE WITH BATY THROWING 7 TDS; WILL HOST MSAC FOR CCCAA STATE CROWN DEC. 10**

SAN FRANCISCO -- Undefeated City College of San Francisco rang-up a 29-0 first quarter advantage on the first four of seven touchdown passes thrown by Turner Baty and never looked back, rolling to a 57-13 win over previously unbeaten Fresno City College at Saturday's San Francisco Hawaiian Punch Bowl for the Northern California Football Association championship.

The state and nationally top-ranked Rams (11-0) will host two-time defending champion Mt. San Antonio College (11-1) of Walnut in the California Community College Athletic Association championship game on Saturday afternoon, Dec. 10.

National Southern Conference champion Mt. SAC defeated visiting Cerritos College, 17-14, in the Southern California Football Association title game on Saturday. National Northern Conference champion Cerritos finished 8-4.

Valley Conference champion Fresno wound-up 10-1 after a perfect regular season. NorCal Conference champ CCSF has won 11 straight since last year's state finals loss at Mt. SAC in Los Angeles County.

**BATY, HOLLEY, & EPPS = 7 TDS:** Baty, a 6-3, 200-pound freshman from Redwood City (who attended Menlo-Atherton High School), completed 22 of 31 passes for 386 yards. He had 38 yards rushing for a total offense of 424. Four of his seven scoring throws were hauled in by Caleb Holley (a 6-3 sophomore receiver from Anchorage, Alaska). They included three in the first quarter -- of 6, 8, and 65 yards -- and a 30-yard score in the second period. He finished with 126 yards on six catches.

Dezmon Epps, a 5-9 freshman from Sacramento's Grant High, had TD receptions of 23 and 29 yards and a third score on a 25-yard end-around (the only non-throwing touchdown by the Rams). Epps had 167 total yards: five catches for 115 yards and had four rushes for 52.

Baty's remaining TD strike was for 19 yards to sophomore running back Robert Burton III (from Tamalpais High and Marin City). Burton (5-11, 195) was the game's leading rusher with 70 yards on seven carries and totaled 101 yards, when adding two pass receptions.

**NEARLY 400-YARD OFFENSIVE DIFFERENTIAL:** San Francisco amassed 638 total offense yards (on 74 plays) while Fresno had 239 (on 61 tries).

CCSF did not turn the ball over. The Rams recovered one of four Fresno fumbles and got an interception by freshman safety Justin Gallegos (out of Clovis North High).

**Fresno** got on the board with 10:51 left in the first half on a four-yard run by freshman running back Robert Johnson to make it 29-7 -- but could get no closer. Their other score came 3:08 before halftime on a 83-yard pass and run play from quarterback Lance Orender to running back Tayathi Minkin.

Orender was 17 of 35 for 216 yards, with Trent Hicks catching six for 43 yards and Ronald Thompson five for 47. But Fresno netted only 23 yards on the ground.
