In Southern California, the Golden Empire Bowl, American Bowl, National Bowl, and Western State Bowl will serve as first-round playoff games. Regional semifinal (November 24) and championship (December 1) games will be hosted by the higher seed.

The winners of the Northern California and Southern California championship playoff games will advance to the California Community College Athletic Association Football Championship on December 8, 2007, at Chukchansi Park in Fresno, California. The championship game is an official event of the 2007 CCCAA Championship Festival. Kick-off is scheduled for 1 p.m.
