COST CONTAINMENT SUMMIT

September 22, 2009 – The California Community College Athletic Association Leadership is going to hold a Cost Containment Summit.

It was announced today that the CCCAA has scheduled what is being characterized as an Emergency Cost Containment Summit of the Management Council and

other key committees to address issues as a result of the impact of the State of California's budget deficit on Community Colleges. The Summit is scheduled to take place on September 24-25 in Ontario. The summit is designed to develop additional recommendations to present to the CCC Commission on Athletics Board of Directors in anticipation of further budget reductions.
