NEW LEGISLATION BEING PROPOSED BY CCCFCA TO COA IN MARCH

The CCCFCA Board of Directors will present 3 form 5's at the March CCCAA meeting. All of them will strengthen football programs in the state. Here are thumbnail descriptions of the changes.

Recommend the **25 second clock** time between plays remain the same as in the past years, and request a waiver of the NCAA rule.

The **second change** is a clarification on the number of practices when labor day falls in the same week as the first game.

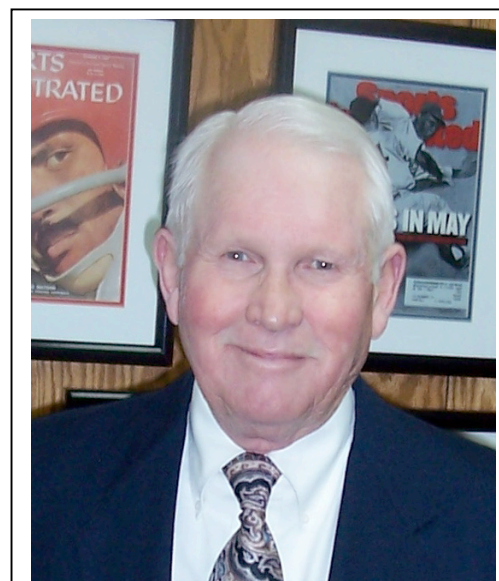
NEWS NOTES

Brent Carder, retired football coach from Antelope Valley College, has been inducted into the All American Football Foundation Hall of Fame. Brent coached 37 years at Antelope Valley and had a record of 189-185 that makes him the 11th winningest coach in the nation and 5th in California. His teams won 2 State Championships and 7 conference Championships, and played in 13 Bowl games.
