Palomar Leads Field At 2008 CCCAA Women's Golf State Championships

VENTURA, Calif. - Palomar College women's golf team shot a 34-over-par 322 on day one of the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) Women's Golf State Championship at Olivas Links Golf Course, to take a three-stroke lead over the four-team field.

The four teams competing for the top state title are separated by 12 strokes going into tomorrow's 18 holes. Sacramento City College shot a 325 to hold on to second place, followed by Santa Barbara City (326) and Sierra College (334).

In the individual tournament, Toyahani Beihn (Fresno City) and Kristina Casillas (Sacramento City) carded 2-over-par 74 to lead the field of 23 women after day one. Samantha Kang (Canada), last year's seventh-place finisher, carded a 77 on the par- 72, 5,750-yard course and is tied for for third with Kathryn James (Bakersfield).

The CCCAA Women's Golf State Championship continues tomorrow, Tuesday, Nov. 18, with the first group teeing off at 8 a.m.
