



CCCAA Men's Soccer Semifinals

Sacramento, CA – Hartnell College came out looking like the dominant team against Santa Barbara City College on Friday afternoon at Cosumnes River College. From the kick off the Panthers controlled the ball and forced the action putting up 16 shots throughout the game.

Less than eight minutes in, Hartnell's Ivan Campas scored on a penalty kick from $\frac{1}{4}$ field to give the Panthers an early 1-0 lead and they never looked back. With 24 minutes left in the first quarter Hartnell drove the ball again with Rodrigo Duarte leading the way. SBCC's keeper, Yonha Adrabi was forced to commit on the ball and Duarte attempted a lob shot that went over the keeper's head and off the crossbar. Following up was Max Estrada of Hartnell taking a shot on an open goal and giving the Panthers the 2-0 lead late in the first half.

With 33 minutes left in the game SBCC's frustration began to get the best of them as forward Duran Stanley received his 2nd yellow card, resulting in a red card and ejection. Not long after Duarte centered a perfect ball to Estrada for a quick shot and his second goal of the game and a 3-0 lead, where the score would remain.

Hartnell advances to the State championship game on Sunday afternoon, 2pm, against defending State champs, Mt. San Antonio College.

Sacramento, CA – Mt. San Antonio College defeated City College of San Francisco, 2-0, to advance into the CCCAA Men's Soccer State Championships at Cosumnes River College. Mt. SAC has won the title the last two years in a row and is now just one win away from a three-peat after Friday's victory.

It appeared Mt. SAC came out with a solid game plan over CCSF, feeling them out and slowly asserting themselves as the game went on. They controlled the ball and rhythm throughout with Sophomore Luis Fuentes capitalizing with their first goal late in the half by way of a flick over the keepers head.

Fuentes put another goal in eight minutes into the second half, but it was overturned as offsides was called. On the 76th minute Edgar Padilla had a long cross to the net which CCSF's keeper, Kevin Gonzalez, briefly bobbed and Mt. SAC's Javier Castro took advantage of knocking it in giving the Mounties their 2-0 lead.

Mt. San Antonio advances to the State championship game where they will face the #1 seeded team in the North, Hartnell College, in attempt to defend their State crown.
