Three From the South, One From North Remain in Men's Singles

Newport Beach, CA (Tennis) -- Three individuals from the South and one from the North remain after day one of the 2010 CCCAA Men's Singles State Championships. Gabor Toth (Mt. San Jacinto), Derek Siddiqui (Cerritos College), Alexandre Picin (Ventura College) and Kirill Sinitsyn (Fresno City College) all advanced to the 2010 CCCAA single semi-finals.

All four faced little resistance on their march to the semis. Toth won 6-1, 6-2 in his opening round match-up before dispensing of his second round opponent 6-3, 6-0 later in the afternoon. Siddiqui played the fewest games of all the semi-finalist winning in the opening round 6-1, 6-0 then going to beat his second round foe 6-1, 6-1.

On the top half of the bracket Sinitsyn battled in the first, in what was a closer match then the score indicated 6-3, 6-3. He then went on to win in the second 6-2, 6-3. Picin was the final male to join the final four, beating his first round opponent 6-2, 6-2 and then advancing to the semis 6-2, 6-3 in the second round.

Picin, who helped the Pirates to a team State Championship yesterday, will take on Sinitsyn in the semis tomorrow at 11:30 AM, while Siddiqui and Toth will meet up in the bottom half of the bracket at the same time.
