From 1978 through 1987: eight-team (five conference champs, three at-large), double elimination sectional tournament, top two to double elimination state tournament.

From 1988 to 1991: eight first-round regional games, the eight winners meet in best two-out-of-three series with four winners advancing to double elimination state tournament.

From 1992 to 2003, 2005: four four-team double elimination brackets in each region; bracket winners to state tournament.

In 2004: Due to state budget cuts, three rounds of single elimination in each region; top two winners to state tournament.
