Santa Ana College to host inaugural football combine on May 5

JCFootball.com will hold its inaugural community college football combine at Santa Ana College on May 5, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. The combine is for sophomores who have not yet received scholarships and players entering their sophomore season. The hope is that the combine will give players added exposure and help them receive a scholarship offer to a four-year university.

Each player will be tested in the 40-yard dash; shuttle run, bench press and vertical jump as well as selected skills, depending on their position. The cost is \$20 per player, which includes a t-shirt and a copy of individual results.

“So far we’ve had a tremendous response from not only the four-year schools but the athletes as well,” California Director for JCFootball.com Damon Dukakis said. “When we heard that Santa Ana College head coach Dave Ogas was willing to host the event, we knew it would be a success.”

Coaches from four-year schools will be in attendance to scout players for the upcoming season. The coaching staffs have made verbal commitments from USC, Oregon, Oregon State, Washington, Washington State, Cal, BYU, Missouri, San Jose State and Indiana. Other schools rumored to be interested are Syracuse, Texas A&M, LSU, South Carolina, Arizona State and Pittsburgh.
