CANYONS WINS STATE GOLF TITLE

MURRIETA - College of the Canyons won the California Community College men's golf championship on Monday, May 8, at the SCGA members course in Murrieta. It was the fourth state title for the Cougars' golf program, all coming under the guidance of coach Gary Peterson.

Canyons received a 3-under-par 69 from Joe Greiner during the morning round along with a 2-under-par 70 from Alex Paek as the Cougars took an early lead midway through the competition with a team total of 362. Santa Barbara City College (365) was just three strokes back after the morning round. Although Canyons' team score in the afternoon increased to 373, all of the other team's scores also elevated in the afternoon. Damian Yi carded an afternoon round of 70 to pace the Cougars in the afternoon round as he was one of only two players to shoot under par in the afternoon. Lucas Delgado of Sierra College shot a 36-hole score of 140 (71-69) to finish at four under par and earn individual medalist honors for the entire tournament. Yi finished second overall at an even-par 144 (74-70).

Santa Barbara's Chris Satterlee shot a 69 to share the morning medalist honors with Greiner. Satterlee finished with a 144 (69-75) and Greiner posted a 145 (69-76) with Foothill College's Keigo Painter also posting a 145 (72-73). All five earned all-state honors as well as a group of four players at 146: Alex Paek of Canyons, Kyle Nicolson of Santa Barbara, Andrew Elliott of Long Beach, and Keith Rodriguez of Fresno.

Canyons' team score of 735 edged out Santa Barbara City College's 741 while Chabot College finished third at 747.
