

California Community College Athletic Association Women's Golf Championships

Sunnyside Country Club, Fresno, CA November 12-13, 2007

With only round two left in the California Community College Women's Golf Championship, Santa Barbara City College and College of the Canyons were poised to duke it out for top honors. That was not to be. College of the Canyons was on a mission to take it away from the reigning champions. Led by Jenny Lee's record performance in the State Championships, the College of the Canyons obliterated the competition with a final round 304 and record score of 619 for two rounds. Lee won the Individual State Championship with a record championship score of 143. Santa Barbara shot a 318 to finish second with a 633. Fresno City College finished third at 669 and Sierra College fourth with a 709.

Natalie Todd of Santa Barbara followed up her 75 score from Monday with a 76 (151 total) on Tuesday to lock up the Individual Runner-Up spot. Four strokes behind her was Ester Lee from Santiago Canyon. Tied three strokes behind at 158 was Kristen Baad of Santa Monica, and Ashley Aizumi of Mt. San Antonio. Baad beat Aizumi for fourth in a one hole playoff. Sixth was decided in a two hole playoff when Ashlye Redmond of Canyons defeated Samantha Kang of Canada. Even though Tessa Harp of Canyons finished fourth overall, she was not eligible for the State Individual Title.
