

# 2003-2004 Emergency Post Conference Format Changes Swimming

## 1.5 QUALIFIERS

### A. DIVING

1. At the end of conference competition, the top **six (6)** female and top **six (6)** male divers (north & south) will be selected to advance to the state meet. The meet will be conducted according to the NCAA Guide.  
*A diver... (no change)*
2. **Six (6)** divers and two (2) alternates (north & south) will be identified to go on to state competition for both men and women. Should one of the north or south regions be unable to field **six (6)** divers in an event, the vacant qualifying position(s) shall be filled by the alternates from the other region, so there will be a complete field of **twelve (12)** divers.
3. *(no change)*

- B. SWIMMING – The **twelve (12<sup>th</sup>)** fastest qualifying time in each individual event, and the **eighth (8<sup>th</sup>)** fastest qualifying time in each relay event will become the “A” qualifying standard. Using the NCAA format ... *(no change)*

### B. Scoring & and meet schedule

2. The meet will be a team championship. Points shall be awarded to first-through **twelfth-place** finishers in individual events and first- through **eighth-place** finishers in relay events. An official team score shall be recorded. Appropriate awards shall be given in accordance with State Athletic Constitution Article 17, Awards.
3. **Schedule and scoring – The meet shall be a two-day competition set up according to appropriate past NCAA guidelines for scheduling and scoring.**
