NOTES: Orange Coast took over the top spot by winning the 200 medley to start the day, but Ventura helped turn the State Title chase in a two-team race by claiming the next two races. Kneif Lohse won the 400 individual medley and his teammate Rafael Aponte followed that with a win in the 100 butterfly. Golden West's Joseph Wood won the 200 freestyle in the next race, but then Orange Coast claimed the final two individual events. Damien Bernard won the 100 breaststroke and Joe Krone snatched the 100 backstroke to sandwich Wood's performance between swimmers from the last two State Champions; Orange Coast won in 2006 and Ventura in 2005.

NOTES: Diablo Valley doubled its Day 1 lead thanks to Mary Struempf's second individual title in two days, today she defended her 2006 50 fly crown, and a record setting 200 medley relay. Orange Coast began to creep up to Sierra in second place and both team's stayed just close enough to make sure that DVC has to get in the water for the final day. Orange Coast's big jump was aided by Diver Nikki Burrelli's 3-meter diving title today, and her belated win in yesterday's 1-meter competition thanks to a scoring error. American River's Anne Scott set a new State Record in the 200 freestyle and won her second event of the weekend for the Beavers. Scott claimed the State's Fastest Woman title by winning the 50 free yesterday and will go for a sweep of the sprint events tomorrow in the 100 free.
