- Participants:**
Lane Events: The first four (4) place winner from the respective Northern and Southern California Regional Championship meets qualify for the state championship. The fastest 5th place finisher from the regional championships will fill the ninth lane.
Non-Lane Events: The first six (6) finishers from each regional championship qualify for the state championship.
Field Events: The first six (6) finishers from each regional championship qualify for the state championship.

- Facility:**
-Track: nine 42" lanes around the track, 10 lanes on the 100 meter straightaway; 1/4" spikes only.
-Synthetic surface for LJ/TJ/PV runways & for HJ/JAV approaches.
-Brushed concrete SP/D/H rings.
-The hammer cage is located on the field to the north of the stadium. Athletes and spectators may exit and re-enter the stadium through the NE gate. Spectators must have their hand stamped for re-entry into the stadium.
-Warm-up area is the grass field located to the NE of the stadium.
- Parking:** Buses and vans should park in the southwest section of the Stadium Lot. On Friday, May 18, ARC parking fees (\$1/day) will be in effect for all non-campus vehicles until 5:00 p.m. There will not be a fee for parking on Friday evening or during the day Saturday.
- Admission:** Friday: Adults = \$3.00, Students/children = \$1.50
Saturday: Adults = \$6.00, Students/children = \$3.00
Spectators will receive a hand-stamp as they enter the stadium. This stamp will be necessary for re-entry into the stadium.
