...3rd in PCAC, all four Conference losses v. co-champs SDM and Grossmont
...6th place in OEC, but a win over No. 24 Cypress
...3rd in GVC, outside looking in with loss to Shasta, head shaker year for Roadrunners
...respectable 3rd place in WSC North
...Panthers finish 1 game out of first, thus out of playoff picture
...Softer pre-conf. schedule doesn't help postseason bid, but an up year
...6th place in Big 8
...Like Hartnell, a 3rd place team in its division, but not enough strong wins
...0-6 in the big matches v. top heavy SCC, finish 4th
... 3rd place in BVC; one of 11 over-.500 teams that missed postseason

- ...new program goes 6-6 to take 4th in the 7-team, WSC North
...win over Fresno City still an accomplishment
