PROTEST COMMITTEES:

The host Athletic Director will serve as one of the three positions for each match. During all other games, the competing colleges' ADs will be asked if they wish to serve. The host AD will provide additional personnel as necessary for this purpose.

PRE-MATCH PROTOCOL:

The following Pre-match Warm-up Schedule shall be used for the one (1) hour prior to all matches:

15-minute visiting team court time

15-minute home team court time

10-minute shared court time (no hitting)

7.5-minute visiting team court time, serving

7.5-minute home team court time, serving

5-minute shag balls, national anthem, announce teams (starters only)

When both teams are on the court during warm-ups, each team shall hit only from the left (or right) half of the court with all hits directed down the line.

No ball handling on the playing area by the team off the court during the pre-match warm-up.

PARKING

Parking is free on game days. Teams and spectators should park in Lot 8 or 8A in student parking stalls (those not marked as “Staff” or handicapped stalls). There are no parking passes required on game days from one hour prior to the event until one hour after the final whistle (our Police Department is very supportive of Intercollegiate Athletics!). These lots are most accessible via the Irvine Center Drive entrance on the northwest side of campus and we do not anticipate significant traffic or parking on campus at that time on that day. Please note that there is no parking in fire lanes or sidewalks adjacent to the field, and fans should use the plentiful parking in lots 8 and 8A while on-campus.

MAPS & DIRECTIONS

From the North via the 405

Exit at Jeffrey/University Rd. Turn LEFT.

1.6 miles to Irvine Center Dr. Turn RIGHT.

0.3 miles to College entrance. Turn RIGHT.

Proceed through traffic circle to back of campus (see map)

Use parking lots 8 or 8A

From the North via the 5

Exit at Jeffrey Rd. Turn RIGHT at the end of off-ramp onto Walnut Ave.

0.1 miles to Jeffrey Rd. Turn LEFT.

0.8 miles to Irvine Center Dr. Turn RIGHT.

0.3 miles to College entrance. Turn RIGHT.

Proceed through traffic circle to back of campus (see map)

Use parking lots 8 or 8A

From the South via the 5

Exit at Jeffrey/University Dr. Turn LEFT.

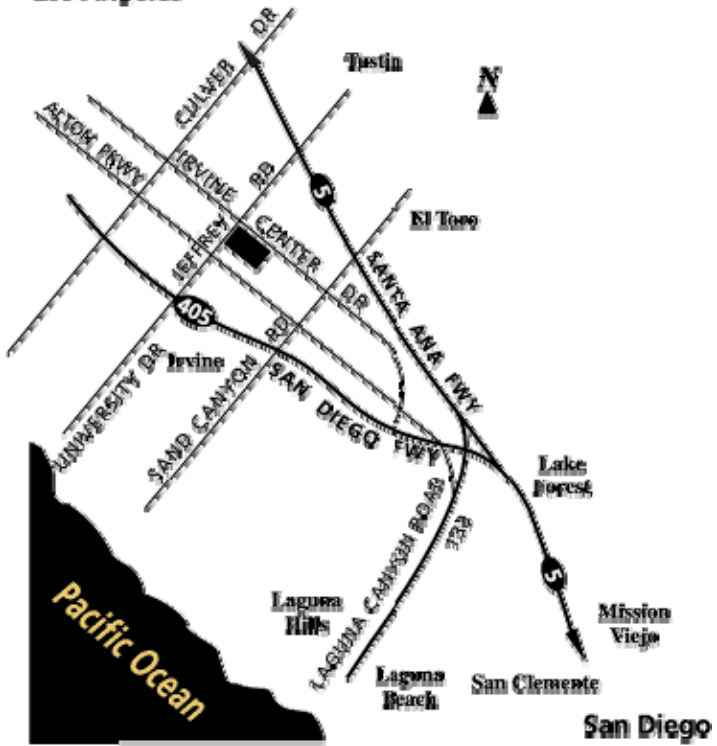
0.9 miles to Irvine Center Dr. Turn RIGHT.

0.3 miles to College entrance. Turn RIGHT.
